

## PLATO CALDWELL PASSES

### Young Spring Creek Man Succumbs To Pneumonia

Plato Caldwell, age 23, died of double-pneumonia at 7:00 o'clock Saturday evening, September 26, 1931, at the Mission hospital in Asheville. He had been sick only about a week. Funeral services were at eleven o'clock Monday morning from the Flats of Spring Creek Baptist church, conducted by Rev. P. T. McFee of Hot Springs, and Rev. J. R.
