

**PROMINENT SANDY MUSH RESIDENT DEAD**

Funeral service for A. H. Cassada, 80, well known farmer of the Little Sandy Mush section, of Madison County, who died in Morganton, Monday, was conducted at the Piney Grove Baptist church, near the home of the deceased Wednesday at eleven o'clock, the Rev. J. A. Martin and the Rev. Mr. R. S. Woodson officiating. Interment followed in the nearby cemetery. Mr. Cassada was one of the most prominent and favorably known citizens of that section, and had spent practically all his life on Sandy Mush. He had been in bad health for some time. Surviving are five sons, John G., and Floyd Cassada, of Sandy Mush;
