

One of the most horrible deaths to occur in Madison county in quite a while was that last Saturday between Walnut Gap and Revere when Jackie Chandler, of the Revere section, was crushed under the wheels of a truck heavily loaded with logs. He and another man or two were said to have been riding on the running board of the truck when the running board broke off, dropping the men to the ground. The others escaped without injury, but Chandler fell so that the truck passed over the lower part of the body. People from that section came to Marshall for a doctor and Dr. Sams went only to find that the injured man had been dead about twenty minutes. Had death been instantaneous, it would have seemed less pitiful; but to die slowly for forty minutes with no physician to help alleviate suffering was agony. The deceased, age 40, leaves his wife and eight children. He was buried at ten o'clock Monday morning at the Chandler graveyard. He had recently re-united with the Shady Grove Free Will Baptist church.
