

MRS. EMMA DEAL DEAD

Mrs. Emma Deal, wife of Mr. Dave J. Deal, of near Marshall, died at her home about 1:30 A. M., December 27, 1926, the cause of death being cancer of stomach. She had been in poor health for about two years, and had been seriously ill for 6 months, her death having been expected for some time. For quite a while her suffering had been intense and there was no relief except by an anaesthetic. Her age was 53 last April.

Funeral services were from the home Tuesday, the 28th at 1:30 P. M., conducted by Rev. J. A. Martin and Rev. Geo. Briggs, interment following in the Tillery graveyard. She leaves her husband and ten children as follows: 3 sons, Hubert Deal of Elk Mountain, Van Deal and Grant Deal and 7 sister—Mrs. Minnie Freeman, Mrs. Mabel Briggs, Mrs. Eloise McDaris, Miss Mary Deal, Thelma, Kate and Maoma Deal, all of near Marshall. She is also survived by her mother, Mrs. Fronia Guthrie of Rollins, two sisters, Mrs. Alice Marler of Elk Mountain, Mrs. Grover Redmon of Rollins, and two brothers, Blaine Guthrie of Mt. Hope, West Va., and Custer Guthrie of Huntington, West Va.

Mrs. Deal was a splendid woman, a devoted wife and mother and her regret at dying was that she wished to live to bring up her children.
