

JOHN HASKETT CALLED AWAY

The last tributes of respect were paid to one of our old citizens on Saturday at Walnut.

John Haskett was born July 15, 1854. He was married to Amanda Keener December 13, 1874. He leaves the following children: Thomas, James, Columbus, and Robert Haskett, Mrs. Mollie Johnson, Mrs. Fannie Duncan, and Mrs. Lydia Fain; and a number of grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

He joined the Free Will Baptist church and was baptized about forty years ago, but in later years he joined the Missionary Baptist church. He died October 8, 1930, aged 76 years, 2 months, and 23 days. He suffered much before his death, but God was good to him in bringing him by this means to trust himself to his Heavenly Father, and to be ready to go.
